

Malawi Bible Project 2018-2019

UPDATE as of 4/30/19

Malawi is home to the fastest growing Nation of Daughters of the King in the World. They live in the poorest Nation within Africa. They numbered 4000 during our last Triennial in Austin. I am confident their numbers are still growing.

In Austin we learned that 40-50 women were sharing one Bible in their Chichewa Language. The average income in Malawi is \$596.00 per year. Their economy is based on fishing and farming; the population is 15 million. The country is the size of our Pennsylvania. Their needs are great. The Chichewa Bibles cost \$10.00 U.S.

As of April 30th, since our last Fall Assembly, we have collected \$13,838.95. This provides funds for 1388 bibles plus the 80 they already have and results is a total of 1468 bibles. So now instead of 45 -50 women sharing one bible, that number is reduced to 3 to share one bible.

We still have 4 months to collect dollars for Bibles. Our Outreach Project ends August 31<sup>st</sup>. If we possibly collect \$5320 in the next 4 months, resulting in an additional 532 bibles, every 2 of our sisters would have a bible to share.

God willing, I know we will continue to do our best for this outreach. We have done an awesome job and our sisters currently will share one bible with 3 instead of 40-50 of their Sister Daughters of the King. I am very proud of our bringing the Lord's word to others to spread His Kingdom.

I am confident we will have improved the spiritual life of the Malawi people and continued Central Florida's Esther Miller's missionary work for Christ in Malawi when she introduced Daughters of the King to them.
